	Early Redhaven Peach	Self pollinating and ripen in late July. It is heavy-bearing, cold-hardy, and resists leaf spot, and the fruit is spectacular.	3/4"							
	Potomac Pear	Perfect pear to eat fresh or keep for later. Requires cross pollination.	3/4"							
	Shenandoah Pear	Large juicy and sweet fruit. Excellent storage life. Grows up to 20' tall. Requires cross pollination.	3/4"
